SITE DESCRIPTION:

This is a small, unpretentious weatherboard building with a gabled corrugated galvanised iron roof. It has a five sided chancel at the eastern end and an enclosed rectangular entrance porch at the western end, each of which have their own roof sections.

There are two pointed arch type windows per side of the building and another in the chancel.

There is an imposing avenue of trees leading up the drive to the church and a massive old tree sheltering the front of the church.
