SITE DESCRIPTION:

A plain weatherboard cottage with a hipped corrugated iron roof, a verandah on two sides (one enclosed) and a gable roofed addition at the rear.

There are also a number of more recent farm buildings and a row of mature pines and macrocarpas on the property.
