SITE DESCRIPTION:

This is a weatherboard building with a gabled corrugated galvanised iron roof. The roof has a large cowled air vent. There is a chimney and fireplace in the body of the main hall. It has sash windows.

There are two additions to the south side - one weatherboard with a skillion roof and fireplace/chimney and sash windows. The other is a modern addition in cement block with a skillion cgi roof.

There is a tankstand at the immediate east end of the building. There is an external toilet block located about 30 metres away. There is an external barbeque shed.
