SITE DESCRIPTION:

A plain turn of the century weatherboard cottage, rectangular in plan, with a corrugated iron hipped roof. It is set on a rubble and sandstone block base. Windows and doors have been changed substantially and a later rear extension has been demolished. The farmhouse is no longer in use although it is still in fair condition.

There is a similar aged timber barn near the farmhouse. It is of slab construction with some corrugated iron overcladding.

The site was owned by Joseph Cooper at the end of the nineteenth century.
