SITE DESCRIPTION:

A small slab and milled timber shed with a gabled corrugated iron roof and a skillion addition to the west. There is no evidence of shingles under the existing roofing iron. There are two wooden shutters on the road frontage, a door to the north and a garage door on the south. The bottom plate has been split.

The site has a number of other small sheds of no particular interest. There is a deteriorating picket fence to the road frontage.

The hut is said to have been the dwelling of a blacksmith earlier in the century.
