SITE DESCRIPTION:

A slab building with board and batten interior and corrugated iron roof. Originally functioned as a dairy but now used as a storage shed.

HISTORY:

Located in company with several other structures including a bush pole and corrugated iron roofed hay shed, and a timber building used as a temporary residence while the main house was rebuilt after fires in 1956. The temporary building was allegedly brought down from Hillcrest and positioned near the front gate. The main house was reconstructed using bricks from at least two sources including the old mill at Millbrook. Following completion of the main house the timber building was moved to its present position amidst the outbuildings at rear.

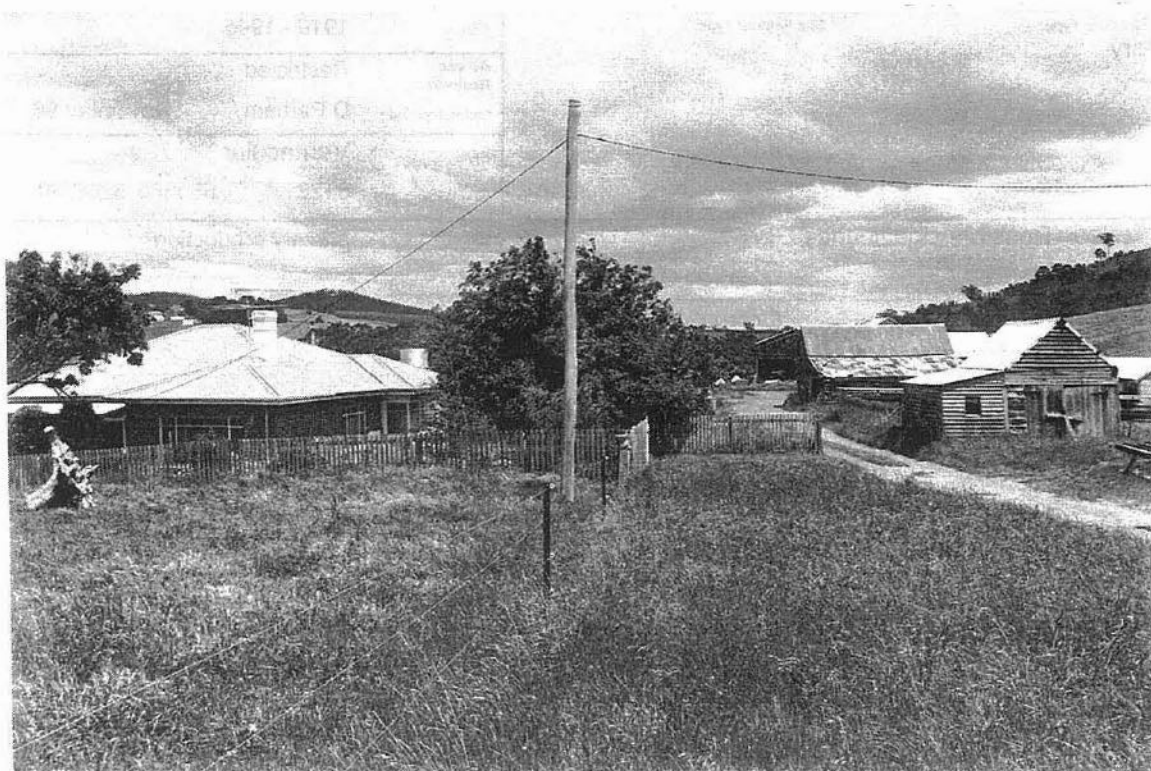
COMMENTS:
