SITE DESCRIPTION: A small timber post office which includes a residence. The building has a simple gabled roof with front verandah and rear skillion. The front verandah is enclosed on each side, one forming the public area of the post office and the other part of the residence. There is a small amount of detailing on the gable ends in timber and simple brackets on the timber verandah posts.			
HISTORY: Originally built as a roadsman's cottage and later used as a post office.			
BOUNDARY: The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property.			
COMMENTS: The now former post office (recently sold) is the only purpose built post office building in the town, the other post offices having operated from shops and residences at various times. It is a typical small scale timber post office with attached residence and forms an important part of the main street streetscape. It should be included in Schedule 3 of the Sorell Planning Scheme.
