SITE DESCRIPTION:

A turn of the century single storey weatherboard cottage with a hipped corrugated iron roof and enclosed front verandah. There are two parallel hipped projections to the rear.

HISTORY:

The cottage is said to be Nurse Lindley's maternity hospital dating from the 1920s. The building is substantially smaller than the hospital as illustrated in the Stage 1 report (p105) but is said to have been partly removed after its closure. The removed section may be the front section of Belmont on the southern edge of the township.

BOUNDARY:

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property.

COMMENTS:

The cottage has some historic value as the remains of Nurse Lindley's maternity cottage, although the building has been so altered as to be unrecognisable from the original.
