SITE DESCRIPTION:

An interesting infill house built between two other buildings and set back from the alignment of both buildings. It is a well detailed narrow fronted Federation house with a projecting gable with a bay window and a small recessed verandah to one side. The gable is finished with pressed metal panels as is the underside of the projection. The face brick is now painted. The front door has a leadlight panel and the house is set in a cottage garden.

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property and forms part of the wider, Gordon St, conservation precinct.

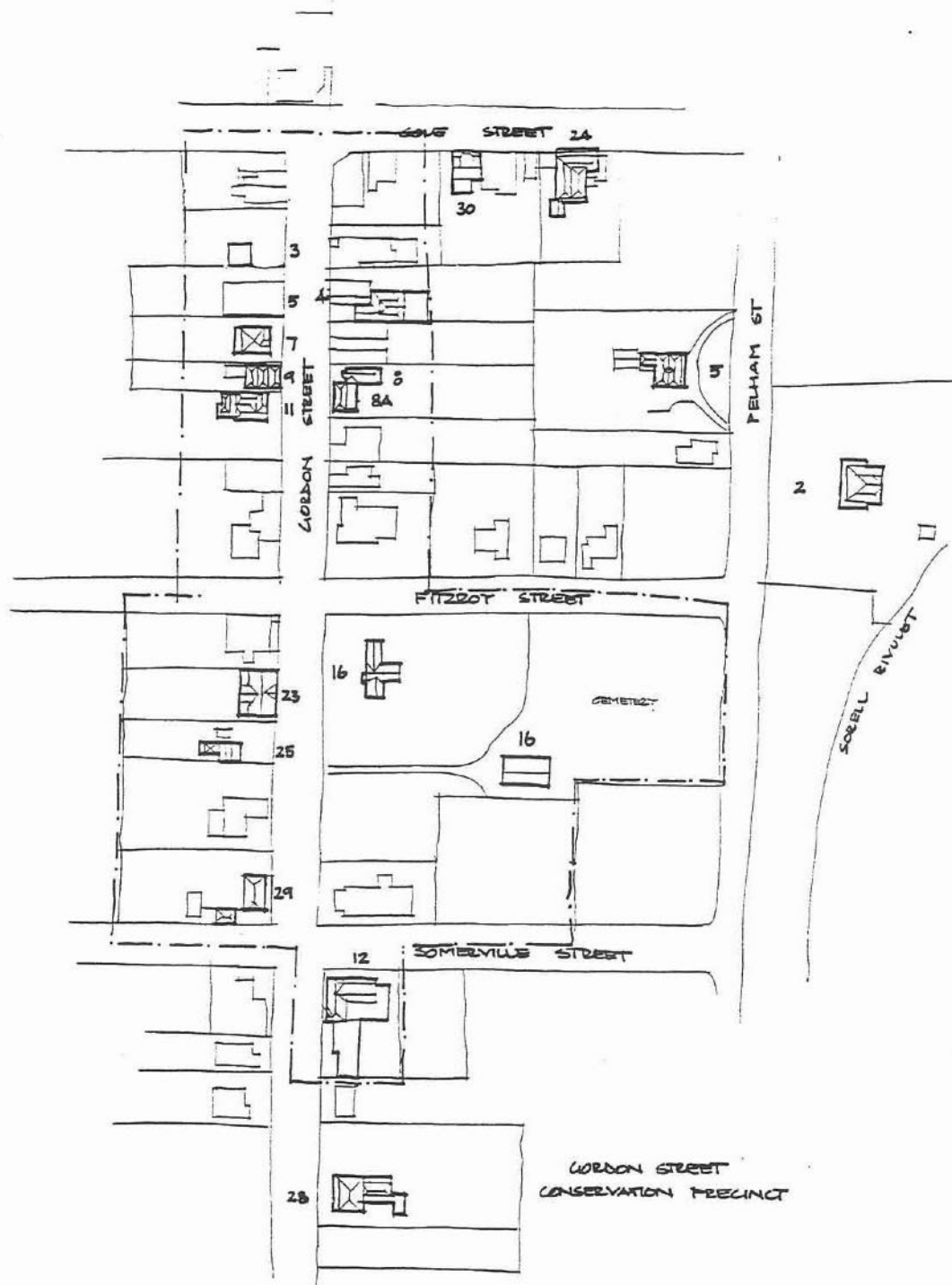
COMMENTS:

It is an excellent example of the Federation style with typical features of overhanging gable and bay window and is unusual in its setting and relationship to the surrounding buildings.
