SITE DESCRIPTION:

A small cemetery located near the first phase cemetery but on higher ground with burials appearing to date from around 1900. There are relatively few grave sites although it appears that there are a number of unmarked graves. The funerary art is typical of the various periods it represents and is generally modest in design.

The site has been well maintained.

BOUNDARY:

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property.

COMMENTS:

The cemetery is significant as part of the pattern of development of the area, for its relationship to the town adjacent and for the social value and links to the early community of Sorell. The funerary art is typical of the various periods of interment. The site is important for its association with early families in the area.

It meets Criteria A4, B2, C2, D2, E1, F1 and G1 for inclusion on the Register of the National Estate. It should be included in Schedule 3 of the Sorell Planning Scheme and should be nominated for inclusion in the Tasmanian Heritage Register and the Register of the National Estate.
