COMMENTS:

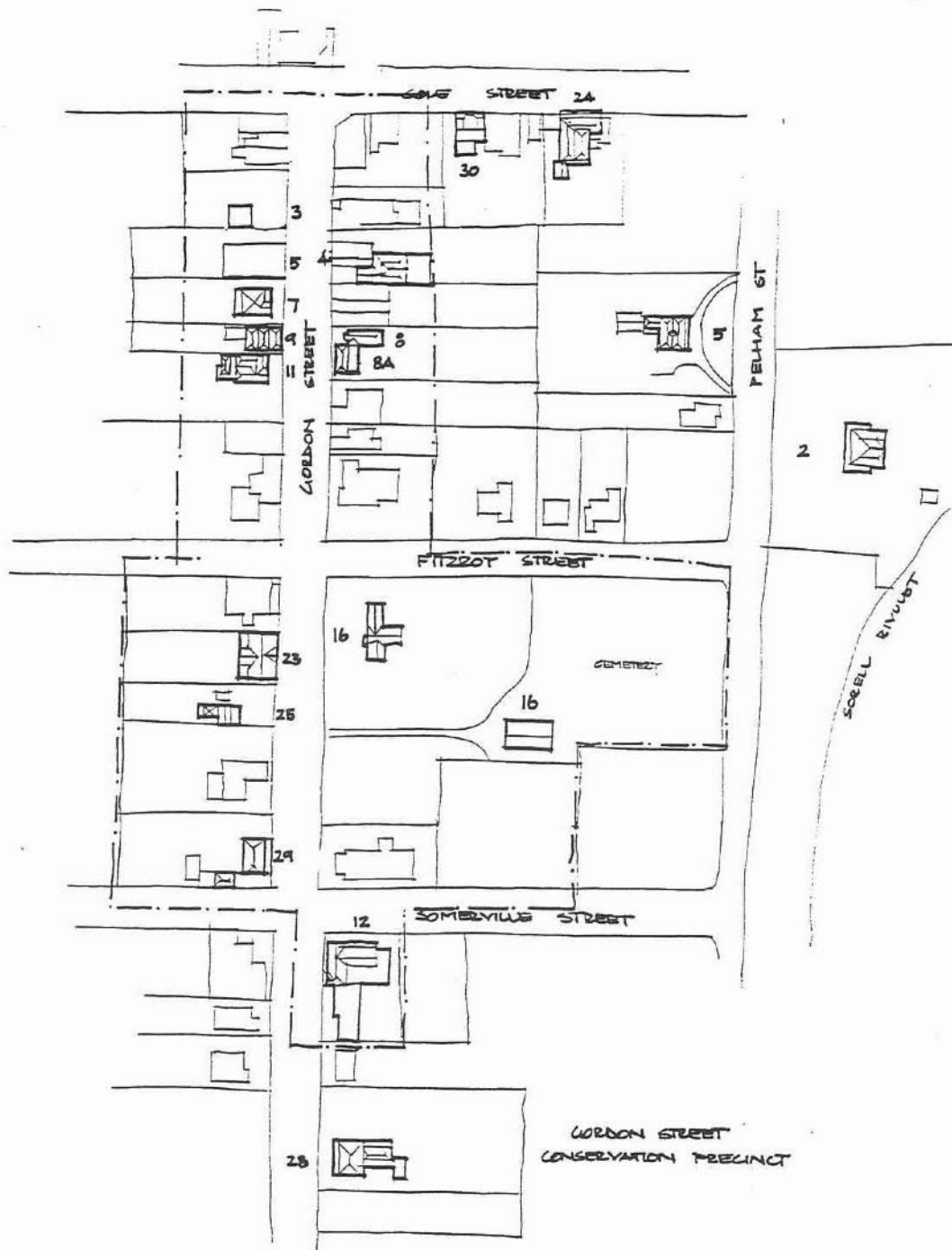
A fine example of Inter War architecture that contributes to the main streetscape of the town.

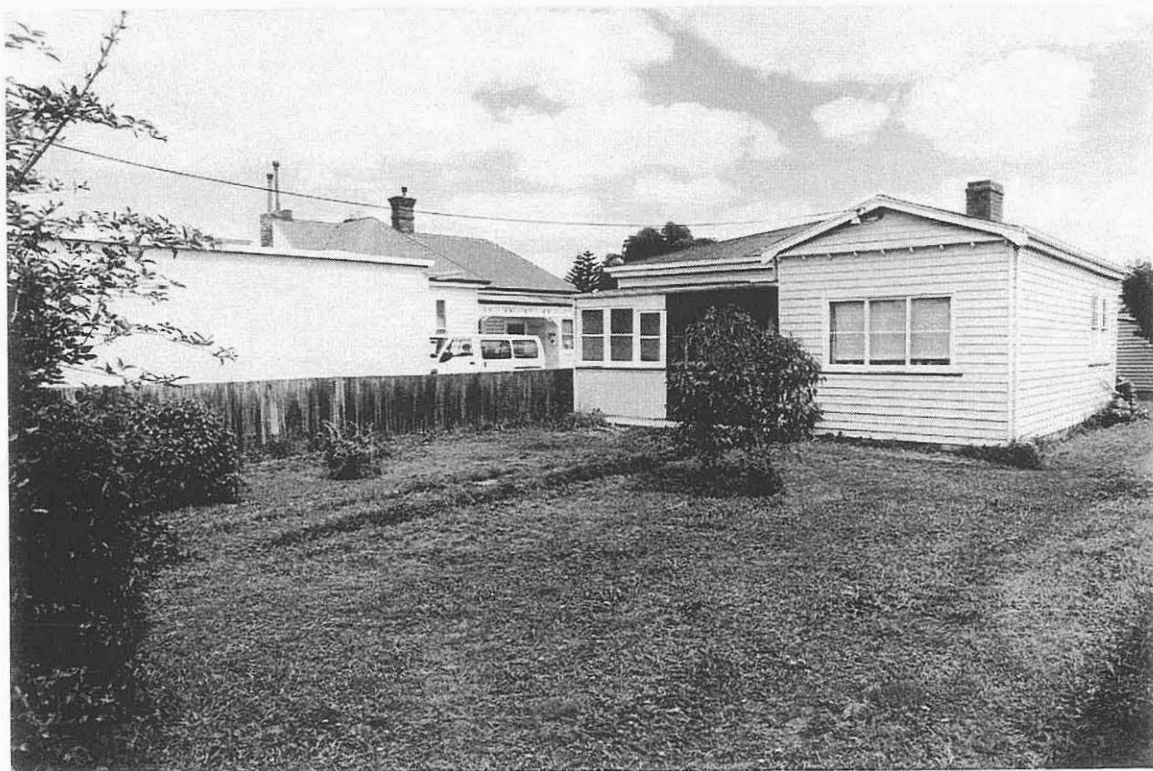
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
