HISTORY:

Located on Thomas Lascelles 1813 grant, the first dwelling, barn and stables at Nonesuch were erected in 1815. The property was raided by the bushranger, Michael Howe in 1816.

Lascelles sold the property to Silas Gatehouse and in 1842 Gatehouse lived there in a timber dwelling. A total of 19 people living on the property including one ticket-of-leave man.
