SITE DESCRIPTION:

The site contains the rear section of a substantial house with a newer commercial premises constructed on the front. The original section of the building survives intact with fine verandah detailing to the side using intricately carved timber decoration.

HISTORY:

Former house owned by L & G Phillips and now a store.
Built in c1908.

BOUNDARY:

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property and forms part of the wider, Gordon St, conservation precinct.

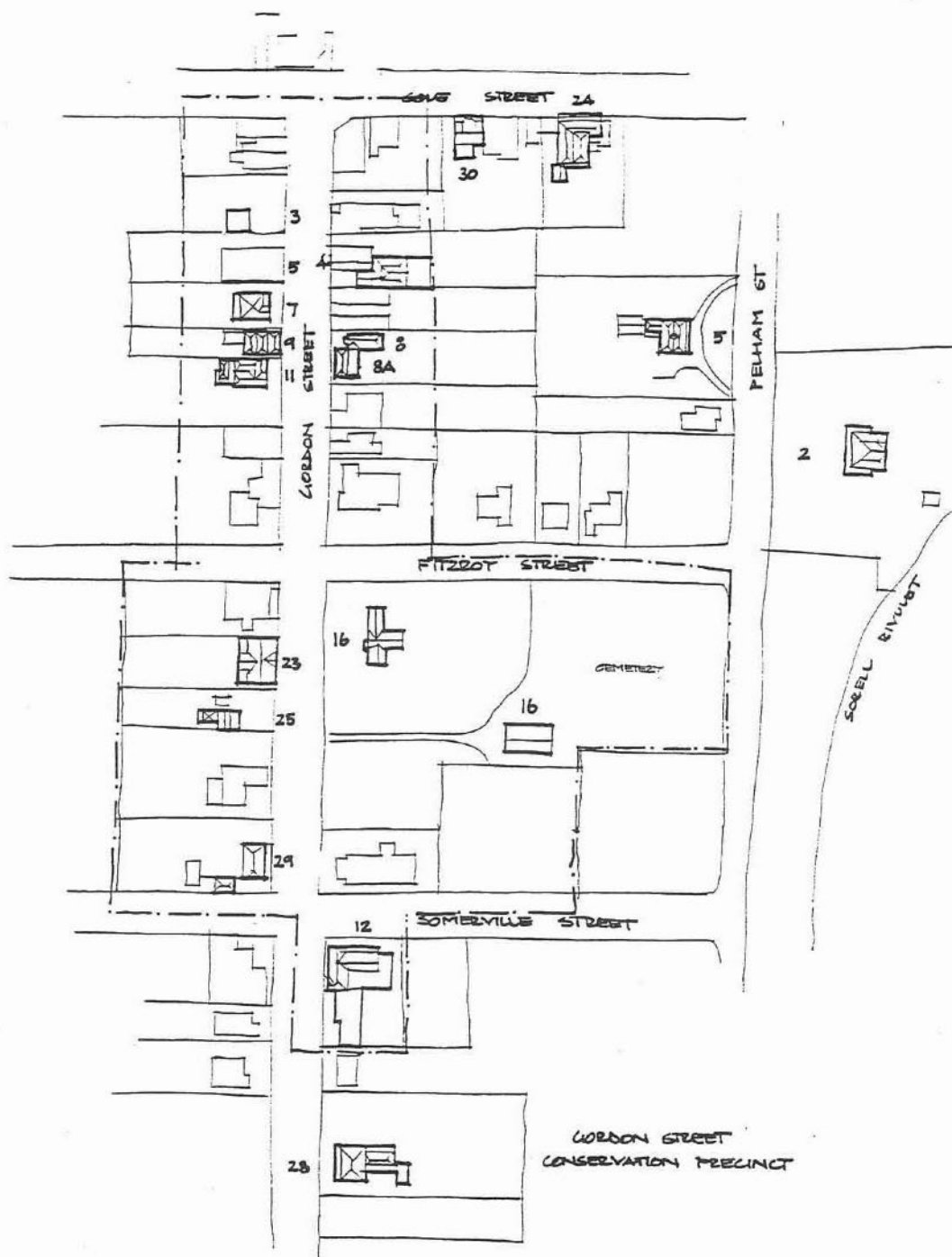
COMMENTS:
