SITE DESCRIPTION:

A small pre-fabricated steel building in several bays linked together to form the small hall. The building sits on piers and has pre-fabricated roof and walls with steel framed windows and doors.

HISTORY:

This is one of a series of buildings, a number of which survive around the State, that were constructed during the war and which have been adapted to serve as community facilities including scout halls, kindergartens etc.

BOUNDARY:

The listing boundary is the property boundary to the east and a line around the other three sides of the building 5 metres away from the structure.

COMMENTS:

The building is of significance for its history, for its construction technique and for its community role and adaptation. It should be included in Schedule 3 of the Sorell Planning Scheme.
