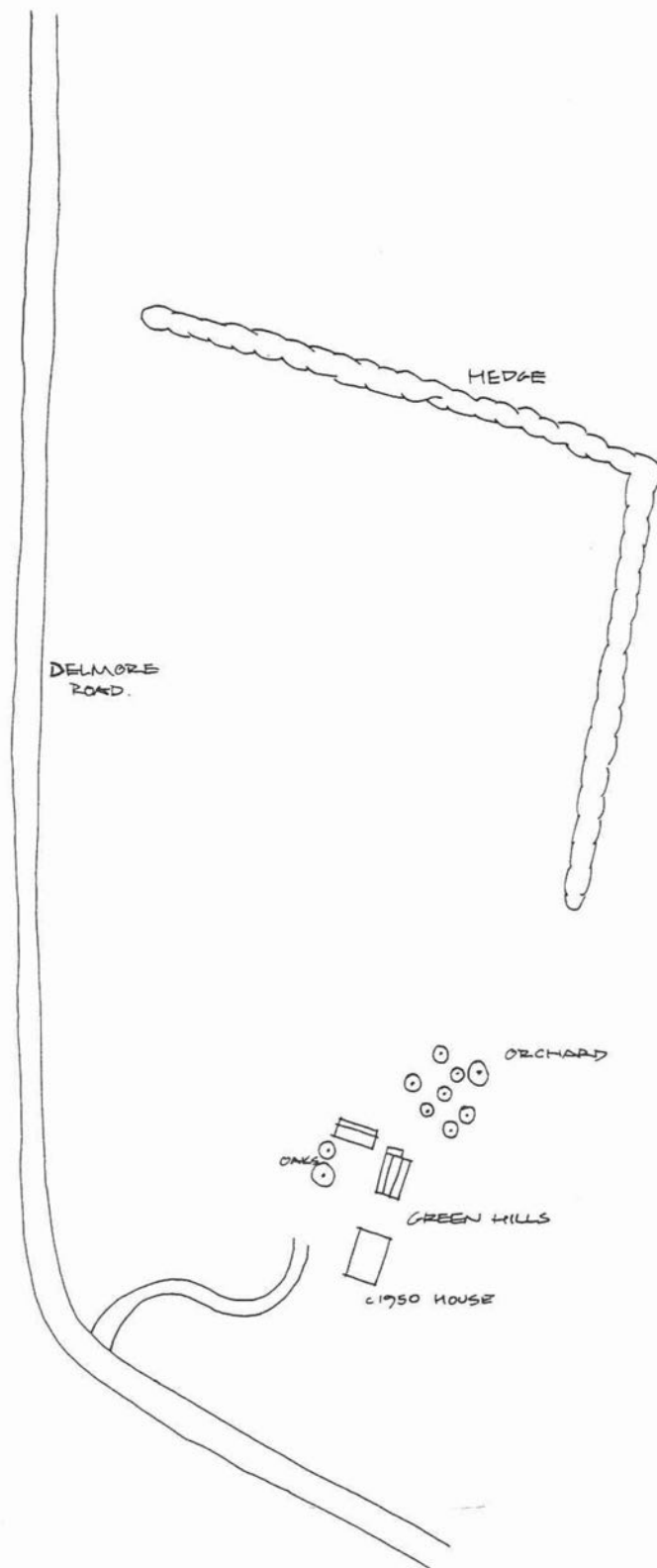
COMMENTS:

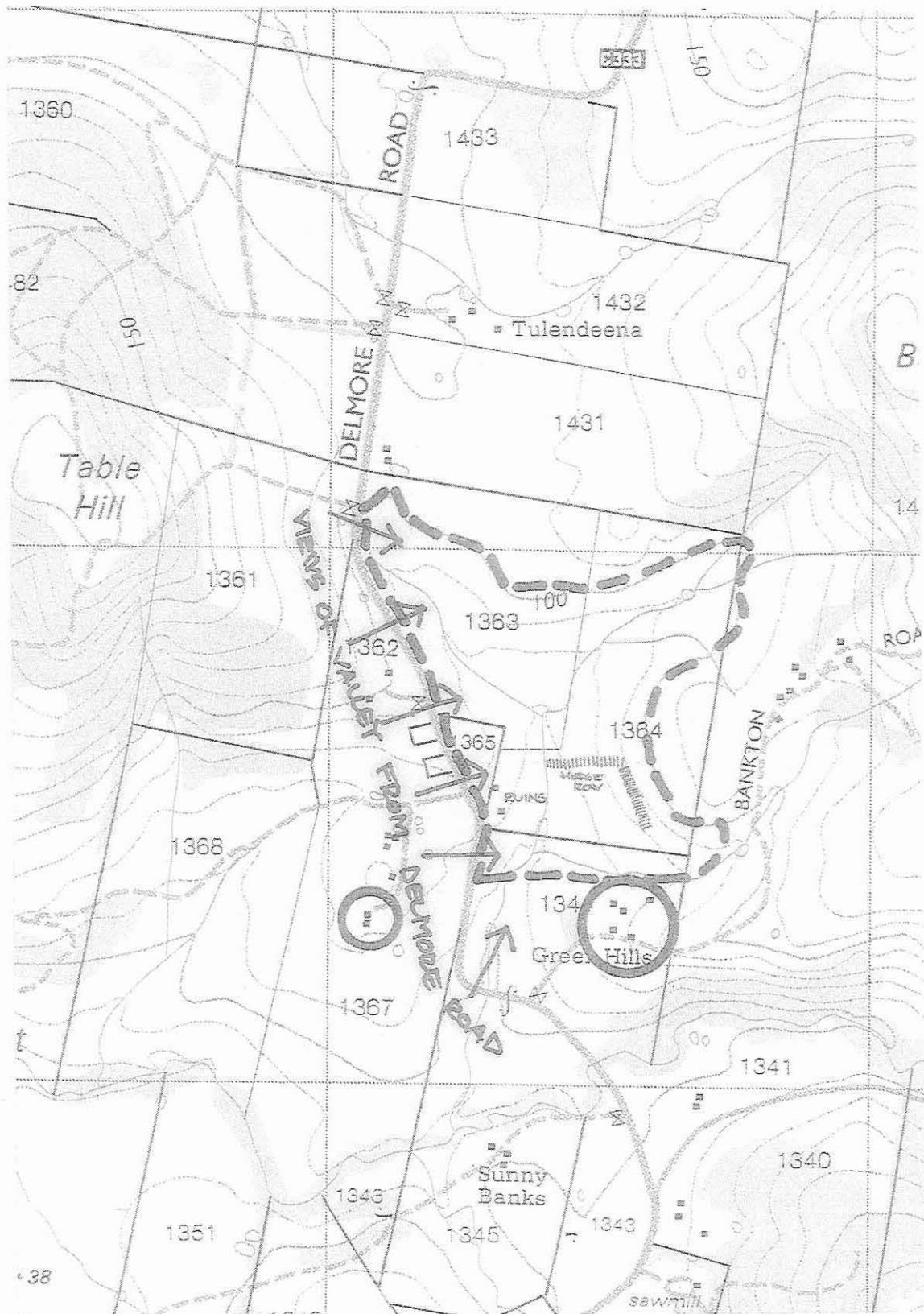
