SITE DESCRIPTION: A small cemetery situated above the Anglican church and reached by a drive from the Arthur Highway flanked by trees and separated from the church yard by conifers.			
HISTORY: The memorial avenue of trees was planted in the late 1980s by S. Doddridge and V. Wylie.			
BOUNDARY: The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property.			
COMMENTS: The cemetery is significant as part of the pattern of development of the area, for its relationship to the church ground below and for the social value and links to the early community of Copping. The funerary art is typical of the various periods of the cemetery's use. The setting with the avenue of trees is modest but provides an appropriate setting typical of the mid years of this century. It meets Criteria A4, B2, C2, D2, E1, F1 and G1 for inclusion in the Register of the National Estate. It should be included in Schedule 3 of the Sorell Planning Scheme and should be nominated for inclusion in the Tasmanian Heritage Register and the Register of the National Estate.
