The monument has been painted which will destroy the value of the item and should be urgently removed. The painting of the letters is very poorly carried out and should not be done on any stone or masonry items.

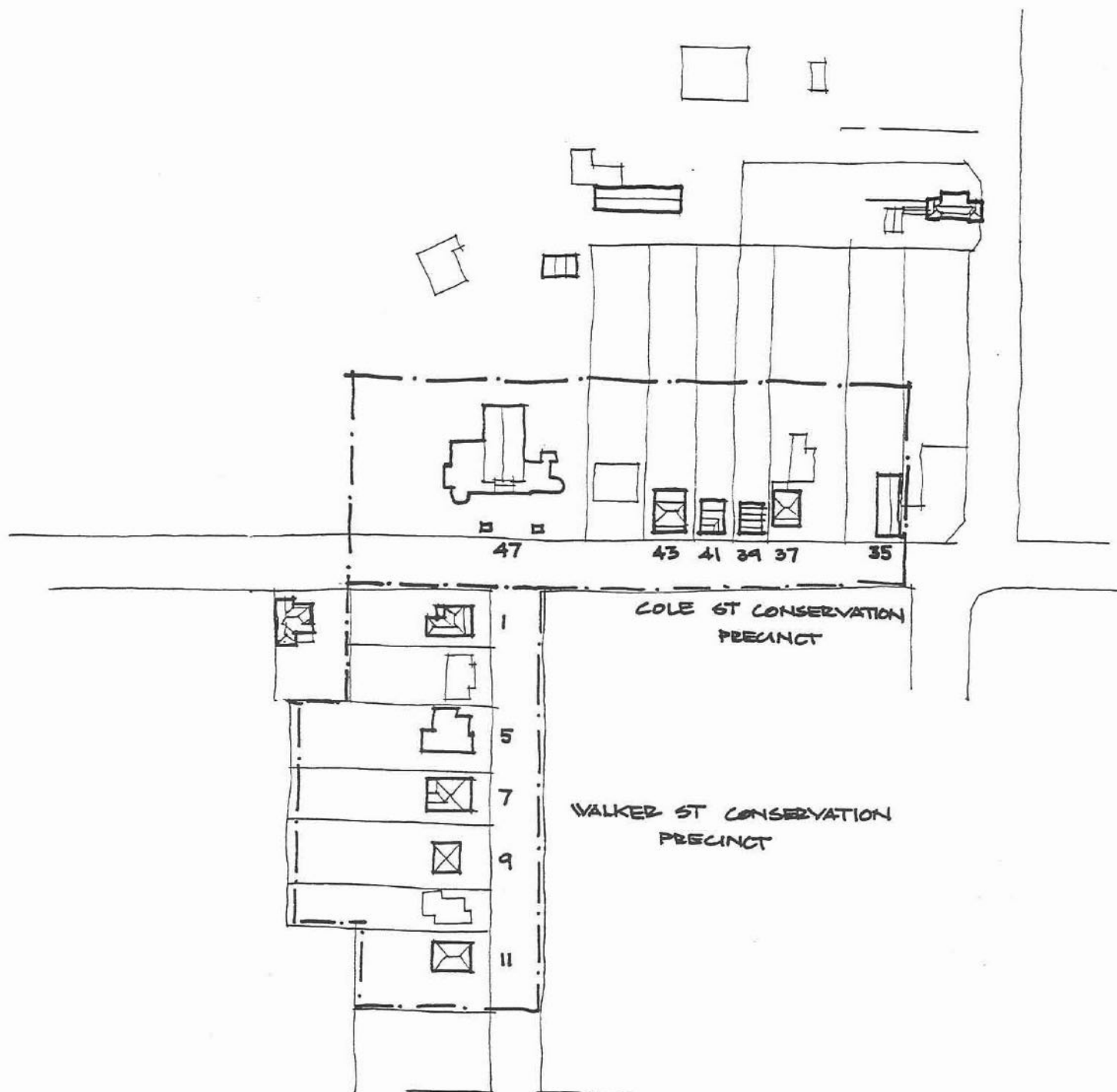
The listing boundary is the site of the statue and is within the boundary of the hall and within the wider, Cole Street, conservation precinct.
