SITE DESCRIPTION: A large garage on the street alignment with gabled form and double doors to the street. It is a good example of an early commercial garage that are seen in a number of locations (another is in Sorell). It appears to have been used as a service garage.			
HISTORY: Erected as a garage by the Schofield family who operated cartage and bus services between Dunalley and Hobart for many years.			
BOUNDARY: The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property.			
COMMENTS: An important structure in understanding the role of road transport to the area and further afield to the Tasman Peninsula. The rise of road transport took over from boat transport and changed the nature of development and access to the area. This is one of several large bus garages that have survived and which form a rare indication of former road transport needs. It should be included in Schedule 3 of the Sorell Planning Scheme.
