SITE DESCRIPTION:

A small timber house of two rooms with rear skillion in typical modest form of early residences. The building has a more recent skillion addition to one side. The building now has a verandah but it appears that originally it would not have had a front verandah. The external joinery is of early detail, the barge boards are decorative and the building has a brick chimney to the end wall of one room.
