SITE DESCRIPTION: A small and unprepossessing weatherboard cottage built at the turn of the century with a corrugated iron gabled roof featuring restrained gable ornamentation. It is 'L' shaped in plan and has an enclosed front verandah and a rear addition. The house is in fair condition although it needs repainting and some repair work to joinery.			
HISTORY: The property has been owned at different times by Frank Desailly Spotswood and later David Hildyard, but otherwise its history is unknown. The house was formerly known as Craig Hill.
