## SITE DESCRIPTION:

The site of the former Albert Inn is approximately known and appears to be on or just adjacent to this property. The adjacent land to the east has been excavated and a new building constructed removing all possible evidence of early construction. There is no visible above ground evidence of construction in the area, but further investigation may locate the site more accurately and material may be recovered.

## HISTORY:

Built in 1862 as a wayside inn on the road to Port Arthur, it burnt down in 1933. There appear to be no remains extant.
