SITE DESCRIPTION:

A c1930 house built for the Jacobson family. It is a weatherboard structure with a corrugated iron roof of hipped and gabled form. There are asbestos cement additions and an enclosed verandah features a chimney which appears to date from an earlier structure on the site

The property includes a number of earlier sheds, a small early orchard and a copse of mature pines at the site of an earlier dwelling.

The house is in fair condition only and needs repainting.

The property comprises part of Charles Kingston's 284 acre holding, although the existing house was not built until the 1930's.
