SITE DESCRIPTION:

A large weatherboard commercial garage near the main intersection which appears to be related to bus transport in the area. It is of horizontal weather board cladding with asbestos cement panels to the gable ends. It has one double door entry to the street, typical of early garages, leaving room for workshop space. The building is large scale and located on the street alignment.

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property and forms part of the wider, Cole St, conservation precinct.

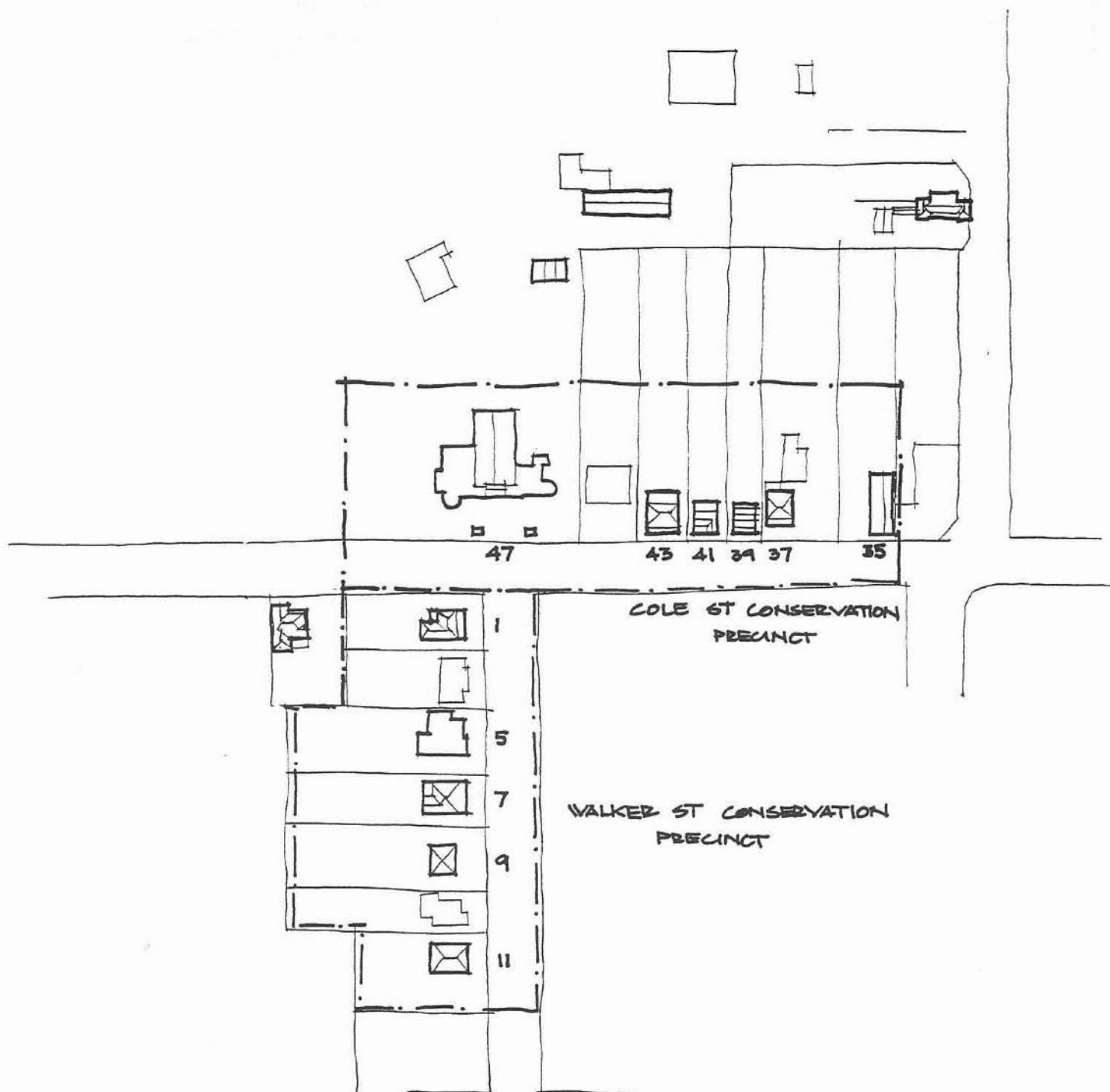
COMMENTS:

It is of significance for its association with the early public transport in the century after the introduction of buses and the role they played in moving people within the district before the rise of widespread private car ownership.
