SITE DESCRIPTION: A small plain c1920s workers cottage possibly associated with a nearby farmhouse. Formerly weatherboard the cottage has since been clad with asbestos sheeting, although some weather boards are being reintroduced by the current owners. The cottage has corrugated iron gabled roofs with a rear addition and external brick chimneys. The cottage is in fair condition.			
HISTORY: The cottage is located on 200 acres surveyed for John Allanby in 1856. It appears to date from c1920 and may be associated with a Soldier Settlement or with nearby pastoral holdings. Little is known of its history.
