SITE DESCRIPTION:

This is a log bridge which has substantial rubble abutments. It is probably part of the early road alignment. The continuation of the alignment continues on both sides of the creek. The timber work has probably been replaced numerous times.

The listing boundary is formed by the bridge and alignment themselves.

COMMENTS:

This is an early remnant road alignment which predates the existing road. It is an important reminder of the difficulties of road establishment and construction.
