SITE DESCRIPTION:

A small probably former picker's hut of 2 rooms with rear skillion and enclosed front verandah. A separate bathroom is detached to one side. The building is timber with corrugated iron roof and is of typical form for the genre of picker's huts. The building has a brick chimney and has had larger windows added on the south side. The dwelling is set in an old garden with fruit trees which is now overgrown and untended. There are several later sheds on the site of no interest.
